In 2004, the award was changed to reflect the change in the administration of the Uniform CPA Examination. The individual must have completed and passed all four parts within twelve months of the date of passing the first part taken. The recipient of the Merit Award must also either live or work in West Virginia to be eligible to receive the award. The WV Board of Accountancy staff provides the name of the winner each year.
